

Dear prospective scholarship applicant:

Attached is the Middletown Valley Athletic Association (MVAA) Pat Arthur Memorial Scholarship application. Each year the MVAA awards up to two (2) \$500 scholarships to a graduating senior who has exemplified a strong connection to the MVAA Soccer program.

#### Qualification and Submittal Reminders:

- To be eligible for the scholarship, you must have at least 5 years of active participation in the MVAA Soccer program. Exceptions will be considered for applicants that have lived in the Middletown area for less than 5 years but have played in the program since moving here. etc.
- The applicant must be a senior attending Middletown High School or graduating senior residing within the Middletown High School feeder area during the 2023/2024 school year.
- The applicant's grade point average must be at least 2.60/4.0 scale.
- Application must be filled out completely and submitted with the following information:
  - ☐ A certified copy of your high school transcript or equivalent (for home schooled students, etc.).
  - ☐ Letter of recommendation (up to 2 can be submitted).
  - □ No more than a two-page essay detailing your personal story and describing how participation in the MVAA Soccer program shaped your life as a scholar/athlete and citizen. ALL essays should also describe financial circumstances that warrant consideration for the scholarship.
  - ☐ Self-addressed stamped return envelope for reply.
- Application must be postmarked by April 15, 2024, and sent to the following address:

• The process for determining the scholarship winners will be completed by mid-May. Scholarship recipients are expected to attend the Awards Banquet.





To develop your essay, you could incorporate any or all the topics below:


- How MVAA Soccer taught you the "lessons of life" in playing team sports.
- Volunteer activities you've been involved with and your specific role in them.
- Discuss things you've accomplished that you're most proud of. These could be related to such areas as school, work, community service, family, personal growth and development.
- Outline what your goals are for the future and specifics on how you plan to achieve them.

#### Letter(s) of Recommendation

Your application must include at least one letter of recommendation (up to 2 can be submitted). It is your responsibility to submit the letter to MVAA. Letters of recommendation could supply information on your technical, academic, work, or school-related experience. Youth coaches and teachers, employers, or persons familiar with your applicable academic, athletic, or community service background are recommended (do not use relatives).

I certify that all the information furnished on this form is true, complete, and correct to the best of my knowledge. I understand that such information is confidential and subject to verification by the MVAA.
